Lecture 10: War, Bloody War



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Reasons the Civil War is prolonged:

- →Northern advantages off set by Southern advantages
 - →North has larger population
 - North had more resources, especially industrial might and transportation systems
 - ∼South has nearly as many soldiers as the North
 - ∼South had better military leadership
- **∼**Modern warfare
 - ~technology
 - mobilization of all aspects of society, not just military
 - ~political leadership is critical

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Changes brought by the Civil War:

- Northern economy grows; southern economy devastated
- Centralized power increased
- ~ Emancipation

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Factors leading to Emancipation Proclamation:

- ~military necessity
 - ~"contrabands"
 - ~modern war necessity to undermine southern economy
 - ~need for black soldiers
- ~political necessity
 - ∼border states
 - ~need for alliance with the British
- ~moral obligation

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Emancipation Proclamations (Sept. 1862 & Jan. 1863)

- →free slaves in Confederate territory
- —does not free slaves in border states
- does not abolish slavery

Thirteenth Amendment (Dec. 1865)

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Battle of Gettysburg (July 1-3 1863)
