

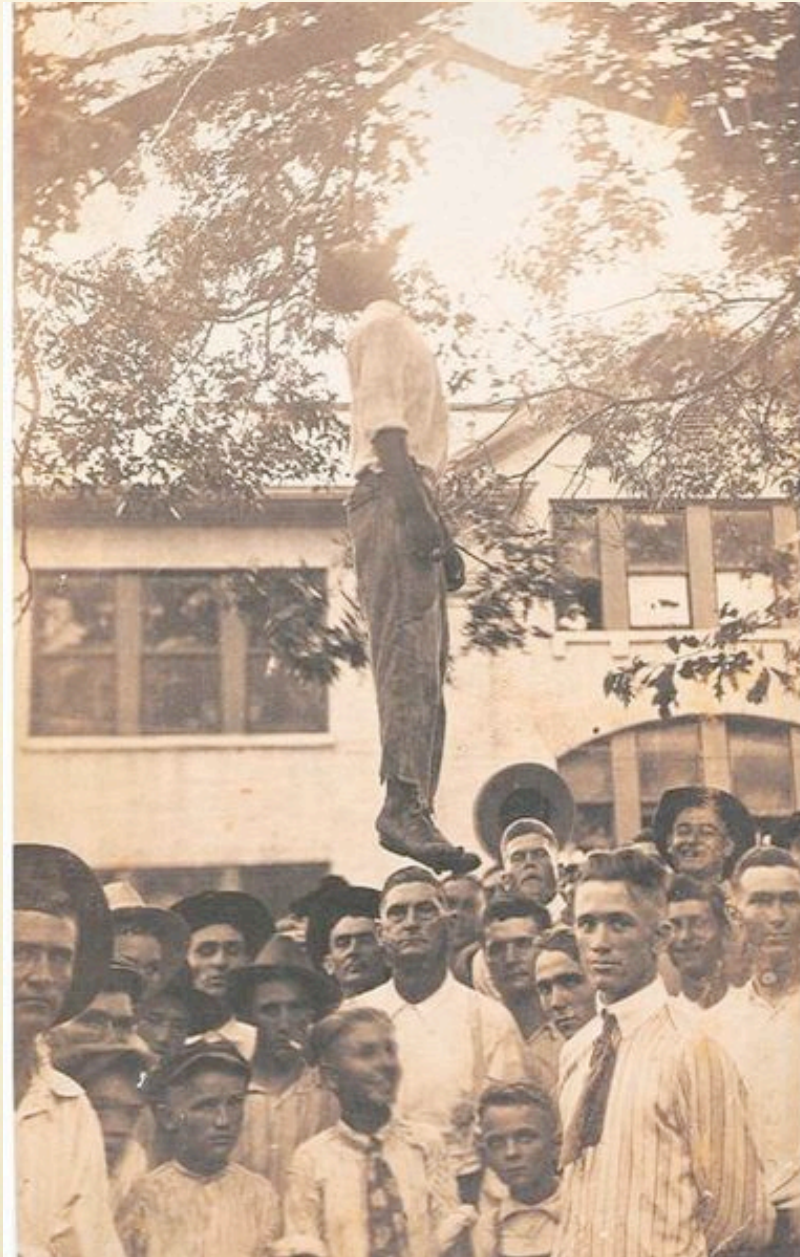

Economic Oppression:

- ~sharecropping
- ~crop lien system

Tenant farming was a compromise between white landowners and ex-slaves.
