Lessons from the Homefront

Demographic change = the Great Migration



- Chicago 278,000 to 813,000
- Mississippi 1910 = 56%
- Mississippi 1960 = 37%
- 1970 = 80% of blacks

lived in cities

1940-1950 = 1.5 million black left the South
